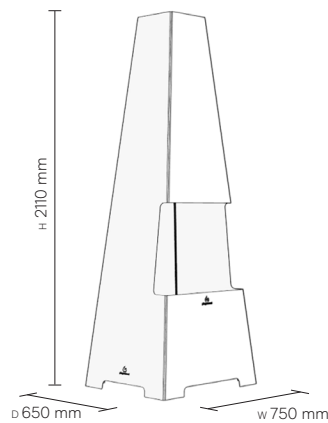

Barbow is a functional artwork designed to bring beauty and warmth to your outdoor space. The Extra Large is ideal for 2-10 people gatherings with its large 3-sided fire opening that can accommodate a log size of upto 500 mm so you can really ramp this fire up. Signature Air Vortex Technology™ and a moulded fuel bed enables for smoke-less enjoyment and a long lasting efficient burn. The Barbow is the best way to achieve a raised camp fire, ready to ignite season after season.

The Barbow is available in Corten steel or a Satin Graphite finish.

Optional accessories are the floor plate.

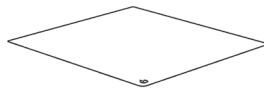

## safety precautions

Installation, construction and usage of the Barbow must be in compliance with all local laws, including those that refer to national and European standards.

## maintenance

A low maintenance fire which does require general servicing every year to validate your warranty. If you use your fire more frequently a general service will be required more often. A general assessment of the bolts may be necessary along with regular emptying of the fuel bed.

It is recommended to clean the surfaces using a soft cloth with warm water. Do not use abrasive substances, soaps or solvents or treat any of the surfaces.



## safety and usage

Your Barbow should never be left unattended when it is lit and should be occupied for the duration of the cool down period (approx. 3 hours). It is recommended to have a bucket of water nearby in the event that the fire needs putting out.

Make sure all flames and embers have been extinguished and are removed with a metal shovel after use as they can spontaneously re-ignite. Deposit embers and ash into a metal bucket with a tight-fitting metal lid.

Do not overfill the fuel bed with too much wood fuel (It should not overflow from the main trough). Doing so will cause the Barbow to become hotter than it is designed for and potentially cause damage to the fire.

Dry, seasoned wood logs or wood briquettes should only be used as fuel for the Barbow. No combustible liquids should be used to light or maintain the fire.

Be cautious of sparks and flames from the fire opening and flue exit of the Barbow. Use gloves whenever operating the fire, never move or touch the Barbow when it is lit/hot

The exterior of the Barbow will become very hot whilst lit and for an (approx. 5 hour) period afterwards, during the cool down period. Therefore, be sure to take the necessary care and attention, especially if children and pets are close to the Barbow.

## positioning

The Barbow must only be placed on a non-combustible surface such as bricks, concrete, rock or stone. Timber or plastic decking is not a suitable surface for the Barbow. A minimum distance of 1.5 metres is compulsory around the Barbow to any combustible surfaces or materials.

Only to be used outdoors and must not be placed inside confined spaces such as tents, camper vans, caravans or boats. Doing so may cause carbon monoxide poisoning, which can be fatal. It is essential that the flue exit and opening has sufficient space for ventilation when lit and when cooling down.

It must not be placed beneath low hanging branches or a roof overhang and it is important for the Barbow to be positioned on a solid, plane and horizontal surface

**Tip:** Check with neighbours about the position of your Barbow before lighting to ensure that smoke and smells do not cause a nuisance.

## cleaning and removal

Use a metal shovel to remove ash or embers - when the ash is cold, it can be used as fertiliser in your garden. A metal bucket with a tight-fitting metal lid is ideal for storing ash and embers. Always place the bucket on a non-flammable surface, well clear of flammable materials.

Cosmetic marks can easily be removed using a slightly damp cloth.

## installation

To avoid injury during unpacking and whilst installing the Barbow into position we would recommend that 2 people should be present at all times to carry out the work.

The Barbow may come pre-constructed. Assembly normally takes 30-45 minutes by 2 persons.

Marks may arise when installing your Barbow. They can be easily brushed off and removed with a slightly damp cloth. Corten steel overtime will naturally heal and remove any blemishes, marks or scuffs.

## corten steel

Corten steel boasts rich, bright orange tones that beautifully ages overtime. Corten steel naturally oxidises to create a desirable rust patina layered finish over months, protecting itself from the outdoor elements for years to come. The Barbow may come pre-rusted.

Initially, rust residue may run off the Barbow onto the ground. Flooring should be covered to protect it from stains or marks.



## storage and movement

Made to live outdoors in all weather conditions, all the time.

In the event you would like to store your Barbow, we would recommend somewhere nice and dry with a cover i.e a dust sheet. Ensure it is far away from anything that could potentially tarnish, scratch or dent the exterior. Ensure all embers have been extinguished before storing or moving.

To manoeuvre your Barbow, gently lower it down onto its side and using a strong grip to carry horizontally. This should be done by two or more persons located at either end.

Gloves are necessary to prevent marks or surface abrasion and a non scratch soft surface for when the fire is lowered down onto its side.

## warranty

At Pingewood, we're proud to stand behind our products and offer a **1 year warranty as standard**, and we'll extend that to a 5 year warranty when you register your fire with us.

To be eligible, your fire must have been purchased from an authorised Pingewood dealer. The commencement date for the warranty period is the date of purchase. The warranty must be registered within **30 days** from taking delivery of your Pingewood.

Warranty does not cover:

- Wear items, i.e. parts that become worn during ordinary use. For these parts, the relevant provisions of the Consumer Rights Act for deficiencies apply.
- Damage resulting from incorrect installation and use in relation to Pingewood's assembly and usage guidelines.
- Damage as a result of overfilling, overheating or using incorrect fuels.
- Heat may cause the Barbow to marginally change shape (straight surfaces may become slightly rounded). This is a natural occurrence when the outdoor fire is used and does not constitute a reason for any claim for compensation.
- Damage caused by rust residue (stains, marks) from the initial weathering stage of the Corten steel finish.
- In normal usage, the paint finish of your Pingewood may change colour slightly. As these circumstances are considered normal, they are not covered by the Warranty. The paint finish will require touching up or repainting from time to time. Maintaining the finish is normal practice and is not covered by the warranty.

Warranty is via your dealer. In order to be able to claim this warranty, we ask you to register your Pingewood by scanning the QR code below. ## notes

*Corten steel may pick up scratches or abrasions especially if it is in its raw form. This is normal and is nothing to worry about. It will naturally heal over months as the surface oxidises further and is covered with a thicker layer of patina rust. This process can be sped up by applying a mixture of water, salt and vinegar.*

*Satin Graphite paint finish may change overtime.*

*Air Vortex Technology™ is only effective when dry, well seasoned wood logs are in use.*
